Stewardship

" So the Lord God formed out of the ground various wild animals and various birds of the air, and he brought them to the man to see what he would call them; whatever the man called each of them would be its name." **GENESIS 2:19**

The creation story brings two points of mind. The first is that God put the entire world in our care; and second, that stewardship isn't something new. It was not invented by the modern Church. Stewardship has existed since the beginning of humankind. Just as past generations cared for and built the Church and its ministries, we must also do so for future generations.

Dear Parishioners,

While the role of priest as celebrant and presider at Mass continues to be central to the worship of parish life, it is increasingly the case that we need to ask others to lead at various other times of liturgical prayer. Whenever you see a deacon or lay minister assisting with leadership at prayer, they are responding to the needs of the Church and acting by the grace of their baptism.

If we have an emergency when a priest cannot be present on a Saturday Vigil Mass or a Sunday Mass, we will call on the newly trained Lay Leaders of Prayer, **Brandt Rousseaux** and **George Wines** to lead the parish community with an official liturgical rite of the Catholic Church called **Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest (SCAP)**.

1. If an announcement is made stating that no priest is available, and if possible, information on the Mass schedules for neighboring parishes will be announced.
2. Then the Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest (SCAP) will take place which will be in the format of the Liturgy of the Hours known as either (1) Evening Prayer or (2) Morning Prayer. All the regular Sunday (or Holy Day) readings will be incorporated into this liturgical format. There may also be the distribution of Holy Communion (if consecrated hosts are available).
3. In such an emergency, the Church has announced that the obligation to keep the Lord's Day will be "suspended" because it cannot be accommodated given the unique situation.

To prepare for these possible future situations, we have asked Brandt Rousseaux and George Wines to attend a formation session offered by the Diocesan Office of Liturgy for all Deacons and Lay Leaders of prayer concerning the ritual text and prescriptions for the effecting of Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest (SCAP). They have completed the training and have agreed to minister in this regard for our parish. Today, and in the future, we ask you to support these leaders of prayer and to pray for them in their ministry. Please continue to pray for an increase in vocations to the priestly life and diaconate for our Diocese of Saginaw.
