Dear Parishioners,

Please keep in your prayers our two candidates who will receive Sacraments at the Easter Vigil. **Dale Hartsell** will receive all three Sacraments of Initiation. **Cory Krinkie** will receive Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion. On Easter Sunday morning at 10:30, we will welcome three recently born infants into the Church, all members of the Rice family: **Mariah Sample, Adilyn Rice, and Nolan Rice.** Welcome!

This week, due to bad weather conditions, I found it necessary to cancel our Communal Penance Service and Confessions at Port Austin. However, it is not too late to prepare for the Easter Season. Divine Mercy Sunday offers the parish another opportunity for Confession.

One may also obtain the Plenary Indulgence on Divine Mercy Sunday. To receive the full pardon of temporary punishment due to sins already confessed, one must make a good confession within eight days of the Feast of Divine Mercy remain in the state of God's grace during this period, receive Holy Communion, and Venerate the Image of Divine Mercy in church or at home.

We are reminded that the Novena of Divine Mercy begins on Good Friday and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday, the Second Sunday of Easter. In praying the Divine Mercy Chaplet, our Lord requested through Sr. Faustina that the Divine Mercy Chaplet be prayed at 3:00 PM, the hour of our Lord's death, which is the hour of mercy. All parishioners are requested to pray the chaplet daily throughout the year.

I wish to encourage everyone to participate as fully as possible in the Liturgies of Holy Week. On Tuesday, April 11th, we will send representatives of the parish to receive the Holy Oils from Bishop Cistone at the Chrism Mass to be held at 10:30 AM at St. Thomas Aquinas Church in Saginaw. At the Chrism Mass all the priests of the Diocese recommit themselves to their priesthood and to their ministry to the people of God. The new oils of Catechumens, Oil of the Sick, and Chrism are blessed and received.

On Holy Thursday, April 13th, we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 PM in Port Austin. The newly blessed Oils will be presented before Mass. We will perform the ritual of the washing of the feet that our Lord performed for his apostles. We will need at least 12 parishioners willing to have their feet washed. Please respond positively if asked. It is a blessing. At the end of Mass, we will have a short Eucharistic procession ending with adoration of our Lord until 10:00 PM. We remember our Lord's words to his apostles in the Garden of Gethsemani, "Could you not stay awake with me for one hour?"

On Good Friday, April 14th at St. Mary's, we will walk with our Lord through his passion, death, and burial. This is the one day of the year when there is no Mass offered. The ceremony includes the Liturgy of the Word, Veneration of the Cross, and Holy Communion. All leave the church in silence.

On Holy Saturday, April 15th, our Easter Vigil begins at sunset approximately at 8:30 PM in Port Austin. The holy fire is blessed outside the front doors of church. There the Easter Candle and incense is blessed. Inside church, parishioners will light their personal candles during the Liturgy of Light. The Liturgy continues with the Easter Proclamation. The Liturgy of the Word will include three readings from the Old Testament, one from the New Testament and the Gospel. The Liturgies of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist will follow. Let us be present at these liturgies to welcome and support our new Catholics.
