Friday, August 15th is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Holy Day of Obligation. Holy Day Masses will be on Friday at St. Michael's at 8:30 AM and at St. Mary's at 7:00 PM.

On this Solemnity the Church affirms that the Blessed Virgin Mary has been taken body and soul into "heavenly glory." This is a statement more about God's promises to humanity being realized in Mary than it is about cosmic geography. St. Augustine wrote, "We ascend to heaven if we think of God who has put ascending steps in the heart." In other words, to be in heavenly glory is not to be located at some particular spot above the earth, but to have entered fully into the mystery of God.

What is true of Mary now will be true of all the saved in the Kingdom of God. We too shall be fully united to God, not only in our souls, but also in our risen bodies. It is difficult for us to imagine our risen bodies in God's Kingdom based on what we know of our bodies now.

The key point is that all that God creates—both spiritual and material—is subject to redemption. We see this in the resurrection of Jesus and we see it in the bodily assumption of Mary into heavenly glory. Mary is blessed because she "believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled," and in the Assumption of Mary we celebrate that fulfillment. In this way, Mary stands as a sign of hope to us of the scope of God's redeeming activity, extending not simply to souls, but to our material bodies themselves.
