Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Are you of another faith tradition and would you like to become Catholic? Are you an adult who was never baptized, or never made First Holy Communion, or were never confirmed, but would now like to do so? Then, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is for you.

RCIA is for adults, youth, and children. At the end of August, we will begin another 10 month cycle of RCIA based on the Church calendar. Please call Fr. Craig or sign up at the parish office. Fr. Craig will be the leader and instructor accompanied by Verna Murawski and other interested parishioners. Any parishioner who wishes to take a refresher course in their faith is certainly invited to join us. In the past, early Sunday evenings seemed to be the best time of the week for RCIA. But we are open and flexible in working with schedules.

RCIA is not only a class or program. It is much more than initiation into the Sacraments. It is a total initiation into the community of faith. RCIA is what we are all about as Catholic Christians. As new believers are added to the community, baptized members of the community are called to remember our own initiation into the faith and to recommit ourselves to what it means to be Catholic.

The RCIA consists of four stages: **1) Inquiry Period:** This is a basic presentation of our beliefs and to answer any questions inquirers may have so that they might make an informed decision about whether or not to continue. **2) Catechumenate Period:** This period begins with the Rite of Acceptance on the First Sunday of Advent. This is when the inquirers officially become catechumens.

The catechumen makes a commitment to study more deeply the truths of our Catholic Faith. **3) Period of Enlightenment:** This period begins with the Rite of Election on the First Sunday of Lent. Three Scrutinies or prayers over the catechumens are celebrated by the community during the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent. The catechumen makes a firm commitment to prepare for the reception of Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil. Those who are of other faith traditions or those who have already been validly baptized will be called to make a Profession of Faith at the Easter Vigil as a sign of recommitment before receiving Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion. Once the sacraments are received, the process of initiation is not yet fully complete. **4) Mystagogia:** This is the Greek word for *mysteries*. This is the period from Easter to Pentecost. The newly initiated are called to reflect on the meaning of their initiation into the faith and the sacraments they have received. At this stage, the focus is on how members might become active believers in the life of the Church. RCIA is liturgically based. This means that the catechumens and candidates will reflect on the Liturgy of the Word of the current Sunday of the year (the biblical readings of the Sunday Mass) along with a catechetical lesson each week. Periodically, I will invite leaders from different areas of parish life to speak to our catechumens so that they might get some ideas about how they might serve within the parish community. We include inspirational movies and tours of the church building.

To register for the 2017-2018 RCIA see Brenda Heilig, Janice, or me in the parish office. Our first RCIA meeting usually begins on the Sunday evening beginning after Labor Day in the more comfortable and informal setting of the Parish Rectory.
