Thank you to everyone participating this weekend in the celebration of Fr. Stan Surman's 60th Anniversary and my 25th Anniversary celebration. Following are brief biographies: I, **Fr. Craig G. Carolan** was born on August 26, 1959 in Pigeon, Michigan, the son of Paul and Evelyn Carolan. After my Father tragically died in an auto accident in 1963, my mother remarried the late Francis Goslin in 1966. I was a student at St. Agatha School in Gagetown until the fourth grade when the School closed. I transferred to the Gagetown Elementary for 5th and 6th grades, and attended Owen-Gage Junior High in Gagetown. From 1974-77, I attended Owen-Gage High School in Owendale. After graduation, I attended St. Meinrad College Seminary, St. Meinrad, Indiana. On leave of absence, I joined the U. S. Navy for four years and was assigned to Commander Second Fleet, on board USS Mount Whitney at Norfolk, Virginia. After my honorable discharge from the Navy, I returned to study at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio. After a pastoral year in Brownsville, Texas, I was accepted by the Diocese. During my final year of seminary I served as a transitional deacon. I was ordained to the Priesthood by John Joseph Fitzpatrick on June 8, 1991 at St. Agatha in Gagetown. I have served a total of ten parishes in 25 years, serving the longest at San Christopher Magallanes and Companions Parish in Mission, Texas where I was the founding pastor. I lived a total of 20 years in Texas. It is good to be back in Michigan, close to my mother who still resides in Gagetown and to be able to celebrate these 25 years with you!

Fr. Stanislaus Surman was born on January 23, 1931 in Stanislaus, Poland, son of the late Walter and Clara Surman. While a student at the University of Krakow, Fr. Stan was impressed by his Priest-Professor, the Most Rev. Fr. Karol Wojtyla who taught him Philosophy at the University. That Professor would later become **Saint John Paul II**, the 264th Pontiff of the Roman Catholic Church. Father Stan was ordained a priest on June 26, 1956. In 1964, he came to visit his cousin, the Most Reverend Bishop Stephen S. Woznicki, Bishop of Saginaw. Fr. Stan remained in the United States and became chaplain of Bay City Holy Rosary Academy in November, 1964. In June, 1967, he became Pastor of St. Mary's Church in Dwight Township. Fr. Stan was transferred to St. Mary's Church in Parisville in May, 1974. Five months later, the 90 year-old wood frame church at Parisville was leveled by fire. Building efforts supported by Fr. Stan's enthusiasm were successful and the new church was dedicated about two years later. Other parishes where Fr. Stan served as pastor was at Holy Family Church in Sebawaing, and St. Joseph Church Sandusky, after which Fr. Stan officially became a Senior Priest of the Diocese of Saginaw in July, 1999. Fr. Stan has always been one of most loved and well-known priests of the Saginaw Diocese. Congratulations, Fr. Stan on a job well-done and on this great milestone of your life! God bless you always!
