**Catholic Services Appeal
2014-15**

Thank you for your generosity to the 2014-15 CSA. Your continued support will enable our diocesan ministries to reach out to thousands of our brothers and sisters in need. Our Parish target is \$45,073.00.

The diocese has consistently suggested that you consider a gift of 1% of your annual income. This figure comes from an adaptation of scriptural references to God's request of His people to tithing a tenth from the first fruits of their labor. For some, a gift of 1% to CSA may be too large. Others may be able to give a gift considerably larger than one percent.

To date 128 individuals from Annunciation of the Lord Parish have pledged \$19,255. Remember that any amount over the assessment will stay in the parish; any deficit will be paid from regular contributions.

All contributions will be used solely for the restricted purposes of the 2014 Catholic Services Appeal and for no other purposes. CSA will fund ministries that strengthen parishes, serve individuals and families, form priests, religious, and lay leaders, support Catholic education, and other ministries and services within the Diocese of Saginaw.
