EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION

The guidelines for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion serving in the Diocese of Saginaw became effective on June 22, 2014 with the promulgation of Guidelines and Protocols of Liturgical Ministers. The new norms for EMHC reflect changes in both the Church's universal law concerning the Eucharist and the particular law from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for all the dioceses of the United States.

For the sake of convenience to our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, they may attend any session that is most convenient for them and are welcome to attend in another Vicariate. Whether within or outside of the celebration of Mass you are required to attend one of the sessions listed below. Following the session, the Office of Liturgy will send to the parish the list of their EMHC that attended the session. The Bishop's Office will issue a certificate for each minister.
