The Great Lakes Bay Chapter of the American Red Cross is in need of Disaster Action Team Volunteers in Tuscola, Huron, and Sanilac Counties. Volunteers are responsible for interviewing clients to address immediate needs such as lodging, clothing, and food assistance. These needs may be caused by fires, tornadoes, floods, earthquakes, emergency evacuations, chemical leaks, or other natural disasters. DAT members are on call 24/7/365 days per year on a rotational bases. Regional, State, National, and International disaster deployments are also available if you want to respond.

The American Red Cross was established on **May 21, 1881** by Clara Barton. Our first official disaster relief operations was on **September 5, 1881** for the Great Michigan Thumb Wildfires that heavily damaged our area. 282 people were killed, 14,000 people needed public aid, and 1 million acres were burnt over. Red Cross Chapters donated money, clothing, food, and building materials to ease the burden of the effected population.

On our 135th Anniversary we need volunteers to answer the call again. Disasters can strike at any time and place. For many house or apartment fire clients, we are the only quick response available. 90% of Red Cross staff are volunteers who are willing and ready to help their neighbors through the early stages of a disaster.
