Dear Brothers and Sisters,

**Happy Mother's Day to all our Mothers and Grandmothers!** Today we honor our Mothers who gave us life and love, who raised us, nourished us, and gave us the upbringing we have. We give them thanks especially for the gift of faith that they have transmitted to us by their words and example.

May is the month of Mary when we honor the Mother of Jesus, and our Mother. During the month of May we might express honor to Mary in our homes by setting up altars placing flowers before her image. We might place a crown of flowers on Mary's image and sing hymns in her honor. We could pray the rosary, both in church or at home with the family.

Today, before both Masses, we will have a May-Crowning of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The whole sense of this rite rests on the exaltation of the lowly echoed by Mary in her Magnificat. 'My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord. . .'

Saturday, May 13th was the 100th anniversary of the first apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary to the three shepherd children of Fatima, Portugal in 1917. Our Ladies message to them was one of prayer, penance, and her promise of peace to the world if her requests are heeded. Pope Benedict XVI has said that Mary's message is as relevant today as it was in 1917. Let us do everything we can to fulfill Mary's requests and to promote devotion to her so that peace will reign in our world and in our families.

Sunday, June 4, 2017 is Pentecost Sunday, the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary, the birthday of the church. The Apostles were sent out by the Spirit to announce the Good News of Christ's dying and rising to new life for the salvation of the world. Through the Sacrament of Confirmation, the Holy Spirit that we have received is continually descending upon us to grant us the wisdom and knowledge we need to be transformed and to fearlessly witness Christ to others in our time. Appropriately, North Huron Graduation coincides with the great event of Pentecost. Graduation Mass will take place at St. Mary's Church on Sunday, June 4, 2017 at 8:30 AM.
