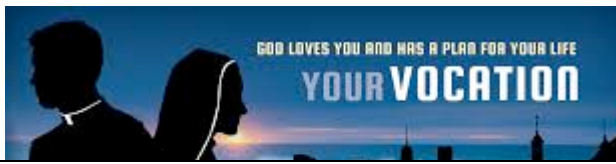
STEWARDSHIP
