

the Blessed Mother repeatedly
emphasized the necessity of praying
the Rosary daily, of wearing the
Brown Scapular of Mount Carmel



and of performing acts of reparation and sacrifice. To prevent the terrible chastisement at the hands of Russia and to convert "that poor nation", Our Lady requested the solemn public Consecration of Russia to Her Immaculate Heart by the Pope and all the Catholic bishops of the world. She also asked that the Faithful practice a new devotion of reparation on the first Saturday of five consecutive months ("The Five First Saturdays")

The heart of Our Lady's Message to the world is contained in what has come to be called the "Secret" which She confided to the three child seers in July 1917. The Secret actually consists of three parts, the first two of which have been publicly revealed. The first part of the Secret was a horrifying Vision of hell "where the souls of poor sinners go" and contained an urgent plea from Our Lady for acts of prayer and sacrifice to save souls.

The second part of the Secret specifically prophesied the outbreak of World War II and contained the Mother of God's solemn request for the <u>Consecration of Russia</u> as a condition for world peace. It also predicted the inevitable triumph of Her Immaculate Heart following Russia's consecration and the conversion "of that poor nation" to the Catholic Faith.

Several popes have undertaken consecrations of the world since the request was made public (including Pope John Paul II in 1982 and 1984). In repeated visits to Sister Lucy, Heaven's King and Queen have insisted that it is Russia (and *Russia* only) that is to be the object of this public act of obedience and prayer. In addition, Our Lord and Our Lady have indicated that the Holy Father is to be joined in the act of consecration by *all* the Catholic bishops of the world on the same day and at the same time in their respective dioceses. Interestingly, only Pope Pius XII's consecration of the world in 1942 included substantial involvement of the bishops. Sister Lucy has written that this act of obedience, while not fulfilling Our Lady's Fatima request, nevertheless hastened the end of the Second World War, thus sparing the lives of tens of millions of souls

The last part of the Secret (often called the "Third Secret") has not yet been made public, but was written down by Lucy Dos Santos, the last living Fatima seer, in 1944 and has been in the possession of the Holy See since 1957. Most informed sources speculate that this portion of the Secret concerns chaos in the Catholic Church, predicting widespread apostasy and a loss of faith beginning in the seventh decade of the 20th Century.

On May 13, 1981, an assassination attempt was made on the life of Pope John Paul II. This was the first anniversary of the first apparition of our Lady of Fatima to the children. Mehmet Ali Agca, a Turkish mercenary for the Bulgarian Secret Service shot and wounded the Pope in St. Peter's square. The Pope later declared that the assassination attempt had been foiled by the intercession of Our Lady of Fatima. The would-be-assassin's bullet was later found in the Pope's jeep. Sometime later, the grateful pope presented the bullet to the Bishop of Leira-Fatima who promptly had it enshrined in Our Lady's crown, transforming a lethal image into a beautiful sign of faithful maternal protection and a son's humble gratitude.
