Pray for the Sick

Dear Parishioners,

On Tuesday October 7th, we celebrate the Memorial of Our Lady of the Holy Rosary. This day is a special commemoration of the victory gained at Lepanto on Sunday, October 7, 1571 over the forces of Islam threatening to invade Europe.



The victory of the Battle of Lepanto was attributed to the powerful intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Church has dedicated the whole month of October to the Holy Rosary, in order to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary in gratitude for the protection that she gives the Church in answer to the praying of the Rosary by the faithful.

The rosary has become a very popular devotion in our time because of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima in 1917 to three children, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta. During the midst of the First World War, Mary appeared during the month of May and requested that the children return on the 13th day for six consecutive months. She told the children that they would go to heaven, but that Francisco would have to say many rosaries. Mary asked the children if they wished to offer their sufferings for the reparation for the sins by which God is offended and as a supplication for the conversion of sinners. They affirmed that they would. Mary told them that they would have much to suffer, but that God's grace would be their comfort. Mary concluded by telling them to pray the rosary every day to bring peace to the world and an end of the War. After the apparition, the children agreed to keep it secret, but Jacinta told her mother by accident. The children suffered punishment from their parents because they thought they were making the apparitions up. They were made fun of by some of the local people and they endured the interrogation of their local priest.

During the second apparition, Mary told Lucia that she would take Francisco and Jacinta to heaven soon, but that Lucia would have to remain in order to make her known and loved in the world. Mary told Lucia that her Immaculate Heart would be her refuge.

During the third apparition, Mary told the children to continue to say the rosary every day for peace in the world and an end to the war. She told them to continue to come to the Cova di Iria, the place of the apparitions every 13th of the month. In October, Mary said she would say who she was and tell them what she desired and she would perform a miracle for all to believe. Mary told them to say the following prayer whenever they would offer a sacrifice: **“O My Jesus it is for your love, for the conversion of sinners and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer this sacrifice to you.”**

The rosary is the most powerful prayer outside of Mass. And because of the grave crisis of our times, we should pray the rosary daily. For example, the rosary is a powerful intercessory prayer against evil, for the protection of our country in danger of terrorism, and for our military men and women serving in harms way. It is a powerful prayer that will unite families. The family that prays together, stays together.
