Pray for the Sick

Dear Parishioners,

Since we were having difficulties on pricing and controversies about the sale of St. Mary Rectory items, I discussed with staff the idea of going with Aunt Netty's Nook. They have priced all items and will conduct the sale. They will also do a promotion on Facebook. Yes, we will have to pay them, but in the end we will likely make a better profit in the long run. The sale will take place on Friday, September 18, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM and on Saturday, September 19, from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM. St. Edward's Rectory sale has not been set yet.

We have several important meetings coming up in our parish: Thursday, October 15, in Port Austin will be the Vicariate One Meeting which encompasses Huron, Tuscola, and Sanilac Counties. On November 3, 2015, Bishop Cistone will be conducting a pastoral visitation to Annunciation of the Lord Parish. The purpose of the visit is standard with all parishes. The Bishop will visit all facilities, look at sacramental and financial books, meet with the pastoral administrator, staff, parish pastoral council, and finance council, pray with them, and share a meal with them. On Sunday, November 8, 2015, Bishop Cistone will celebrate Sunday Masses in the parish with coffee and deserts after each Mass in order to meet the parishioners.

The regional meetings held during the last year have been cancelled. In place of those meetings, two representatives from the Diocese will conduct a listening session with pastor and staff. This meeting is scheduled to take place in our parish on Wednesday, November 18, from 1:00 to 3:00 PM. We are presently working on getting two separate Restricted Building Funds started, one for St. Mary's and one for St. Michael's. Monthly collection envelopes will be printed for both communities and sent out with the envelope packets. All restricted building funds will be used only for church restoration/construction purposes, particularly for the bathrooms at St. Mary and for the foundation/bathrooms in St. Michael. St. Mary's funds will stay in St. Mary's and St. Michael's funds will stay in St. Michael's. Since the fans at St. Mary's were fixed, the funds collected for new fans can now go into St. Mary's building fund.

At this week's parish pastoral council, it was discussed how to best communicate parish building projects to the public. Possibilities discussed were newspaper articles and posters with drawings and descriptions of the projects at the entrances of the churches. I have also had experiences myself of explaining construction projects in layman's terms during and outside of Masses.
