**Dear Brothers and Sisters,**

Are you of another faith tradition and would you like to become Catholic? Are you an adult who was never baptized, never made First Holy Communion, or never confirmed, but would now like to do so? Then Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is for you. RCIA is particularly for adults, although it can include the youth as well. Fr. Craig will be the leader and instructor. Informal meetings will be held weekly at the Parish Rectory. The schedule that seems to work best for most is Sunday afternoons from 5:00-6:30 PM.

The RCIA is based on Liturgy and Scripture, meaning that inquirers will reflect on the Scriptures of each Sunday Mass and on each season of the Church year. Each meeting will cover a different topic. Besides attending weekly meetings, Sunday Mass will be obligatory as well.

RCIA is more than simply initiating new members into the Sacraments. It is a total immersion into the community of faith. It is what we are all about as Christians. As new believers are added to the community, we as members of the community are called to remember our own initiation into the faith and to recommit ourselves to what it means to be Catholic.

To enroll for this year's RCIA, simply call Brenda Heilig, Janice Pionk or Fr. Craig at the parish office and let us know if you will be coming. Our first RCIA meeting will be on Sunday evening, September 10 at 5:00 PM at the Parish Rectory.
