ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED A ROSARY FOR THIS MONTH'S "CHURCH TIME".

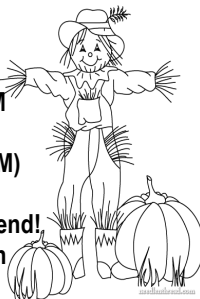
Can tabs, Spartan labels, and earned moneys (especially “Pennies for Haiti”) will be collected during each “Church Time”.
