

## Worship Meeting Minutes

February 11, 2015

Meeting opened with a prayer by Fr. Craig

Present were Fr. Craig, Stan and Gen Kondziolka, Sr. Judy, Connie Baranski, Ken Wisneski

The following items were discussed:

- Lent and Easter 2015 Schedule: Made necessary corrections to times and places.
- Also discussed that on February 14-15, 2015 Anointing of the Sick will take place at all Masses.
- Ash Wednesday discussion on burning of Palms for ashes. Schedule of Liturgies with ashes: 8:30 AM St. Michael, 12:00 Noon Liturgy of the Word at St. Edward, and 7:00 PM Mass at St. Mary with crucifix to be placed prominently up front in church for beginning of Lent.

Discussion on Holy Week and Easter:

- Palm Sunday: Palms will be available at all Masses with processions at both churches.
- Any parishioner is welcome to attend Holy Tuesday Christ Mass at St. Mary Cathedral in Saginaw at 10:30 AM. Sr. Judy to be inviting First Communion, Confirmation, Reconciliation children and their parents to participate in this Mass. RCIA candidates will also be invited to be involved in this Mass.
- We would also like the above to be present during the presentation of the oils to the parish at the 7:00 PM Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper. Sr. Judy to keep us informed on the children attending.
- Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper at St. Michael will include the Rite of Washing of Feet of 12 parishioners. Adoration of the Holy Eucharist to follow for one hour. All parishioners are encouraged to attend. Our Lord said to his disciples: "*Could you not keep watch with me for one hour?*"
- Good Friday Liturgy of the Passion of Our Lord at St. Mary's 1:00 PM followed by Stations of the Cross.
- Holy Saturday Easter Vigil at St. Michael to start after complete sunset and no hint of daylight present at approximately 8:30 PM.
- Easter Sunday Masses is the regular Sunday schedule: 8:30 AM St. Mary and 10:30 AM St. Michael.
- Divine Mercy Sunday Devotion is the Second Sunday of Easter, April 12, 2015. Special Eucharistic Adoration at 2:00 PM with the recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available in which one may receive a *Full Plenary Indulgence* on this Sunday.

The meeting closed with prayer.
