What is the International Pilgrim Virgin of Fatima?

The International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima is a world-famous statue of the Virgin Mary. It is one of two "twin" statues sculpted in 1947 by José Thedim to reflect the precise instructions of Sister Lucia. The Bishop of Fatima entrusted the image to John Haffert, co-founder of the Blue Army, and prayed that Mary herself accompany the statue wherever it goes. The statue has traveled around the globe many times for nearly 70 years and is now under the auspices of the World Apostolate of Fatima, USA. Since 1947, the mission of the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Fatima remains unchanged: to spread the message of Fatima - the message of salvation - to a world in need. Having journeyed to over 100 countries, the International Pilgrim Virgin Statue has brought Mary's potent message of salvation and hope to millions. 
